CIVIL EMERGENCY CURFEW

Be It ORDAINED And enacted by the Board Of Mayor and Alderman of The Town Of Sturgis, Ms. as follows:

Wheras, Town Of Sturgis, Mississippi, will pass an ordiance , Civil Emergency Curfew , Definition

The following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them:


(a) CIVIL EMERGENCY:


- (1) A riot or unlawful assembly characterized by any use or force or violence disturbing the public peace, or any threat to use such force and violence, if accompanied by immediate power of execution, by (2) or more persons acting together and without authority of law.
- (2) An natural diaster or manmade calamity, including but not limited to flood, conflagration, cyclone, tornado, earthquake, or explosion within the geographic limits of a municipality resulting in the death or injury of persons, or the destruction of property.
